Last week, the "Center for Near East Policy Research" acquired the new school book curriculum used by The Palestinian Authority and UNRWA schools in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria & Gaza.

The US State Department informed the Center that the new Palestinian Authority school books are "devoid of incitement" and "conform to standards of peaceful education."

Are the new Palestinian Authority school books a show case for peaceful education?

In our report on new Palestinian Authority books introduced in 2013, we found that the textbooks used by teachers in UNRWA schools and the Palestinian Authority (PA) DE-legitimized Jews and denied Israel's right to exist. Jews are depicted as demons, wolves, pigs and dogs. The 2013 curriculum teaches the children that it is their obligation to be involved in a violent resistance and there is no encouragement for peaceful co-existence. The curriculum calls for Jihadist sainthood, and stresses the children's right to return to "Their ancestral Pre-1948 villages" which no longer exist.
