

After 49 Years of Deir Yassin Massacre.

Killing Becomes an Israeli Profession;

Today coincides with the 49th anniversary of Deir Yassin massacre perpetrated by outlawed Jewish gangsters against the Palestinian people. Since then the genocide campaign and the mass collective deportation policies applied against the Palestinian people were the main features characterizing and governing the conduct of these Jewish gangs.

The history of the Israeli state is just a full record of horrible crimes committed against the Arab people in general and the Palestinians in particular.

During the past five decades no single Arab state had escaped a spearheaded Israeli aggression to the extent of using this Hebrew state a base for gangsters to launch their attacks.

This fact has been first ascertained by the founder of the state of Israel David Bin Gourion when saying "We will make the war an Israeli craft", because he was fully aware that his battle to distort historic facts, will never triumph without resorting to terror and violence.

It is seemingly evident that Israel and its herds of settlers have followed suit the commandments and the same line of Ben Gourion when they committed horrible massacres against the Palestinian refugee camps of Sabra and Shatila, Hizma and Kharbatha villages, and Hebron in addition to many other locations still to come.

There is a close connection between the determination of the Netanyahu government to uphold settlement projects in the Palestinian land and promoting genocide and terror techniques against our people. Shortly after Netanyahu has announced his three "nos", for most of which comes no to freezing settlements, his settlers responded in Hebron by translating his words into deeds... into bullets fired against Hebron stone-throwers killing three of them yesterday.

The record of the Israeli schematic crime against our people remains a stain of shame to an human values and to civilization.

Despite all these shining facts, most human rights organization in the USA still argue that the Palestinians should abandon violence.

What violence is more worse than the daily massacres committed over the past five decades by the Jews against the Palestinians.

The American administration should not dissolve itself from direct responsibility when receiving Netanyahu and publicly announcing that it is not going to exercise any kind of pressure against him while his settlers are killing more Palestinians and boast to declare that they will not revise their settlement policy.!! The outcome of Netanyahu's visit to Washington, has appeared in Hebron even before returning back to Tel-Aviv.

What is going on today is pushing the whole region on the brink of a new disaster, and threatens to widen the cycle of violence, blood shed.
