

Palestinian Arab Terrorists Who Have Taken Part in the Murders of Americans Since the Oslo Accords (Sept.1993)

1. **Mohammed Dief:** Dief, a senior Hamas terrorist, is suspected of planning the October 9, 1994 kidnap-murder of Nachshon Wachsman, an American-Israeli. (*Jerusalem Post*, August 23, 1996)

According to an Israeli Justice Ministry report on October 21, 1998, Dief is a free man, residing in PA territory.

2. **Abd al-Majid Dudin:** According to the Israeli government, Dudin trained the terrorist who carried out the August 21, 1995 Jerusalem bus bombing, in which Connecticut school teacher Joan Davenny was murdered.

On March 12, 1996, Israel asked the Palestinian Authority to extradite Dudin. The PA has ignored the request. In July 1996, Dudin was arrested by the PA police and sentenced to 12 years in prison. Peace Watch, a non-partisan group that monitors violations of the Oslo accords, reported in 1996 that "even though Dudin officially remains in prison in Jericho, he actually works as a jailer and is permitted freedom of movement in Jericho."

According to a November 1998 Israeli government report, Dudin is a free man, residing in PA territory.

3. **Adnan al-Ghoul** According to an Israeli Justice Ministry Report on October 21, 1998, al-Ghoul was involved in the April 9, 1995, bombing attack on an Israeli bus near Kfar Darom, in which seven Israelis and one American, Alisa Flatow, a student at Brandeis University were killed. Al-Ghoul is reportedly in PA detention, although, even if true, that would not relieve the PA of its obligation, in the Oslo accords, to extradite Al-Ghoul to Israel.

4. **Ibrahim Ghneimat:** He has been identified by the Israeli government as a prime suspect in the June 9, 1996, drive-by shooting near Beit Shemesh, in which Yaron Ungar, a 25 year-old American-Israeli schoolteacher, was killed. (Ungar's

wife, Efrat, was also killed in the attack.) On September 17, 1997, Israel asked the PA to extradite Ghneimat; the PA ignored the request.

According to an Israeli Justice Ministry report on October 21, 1998, Ghneimat is "under arrest by the PA, but is given permission to come and go as he pleases."

5. **Mahmoud Abu Hanudeh:** Hanudeh, 34, a resident of the village of Azira Shamalya, has been identified by Israeli security officials as one of the ringleaders of the terrorists who set off bombs in Jerusalem's Mahane Yehuda marketplace on July 30, 1997 (in which Mrs. Leah Stern, an American-Israeli, formerly of New Jersey, was killed) and on Ben-Yehuda Street in downtown Jerusalem on September 4, 1997 (in which Yael Botwin, a 14 year-old American-Israeli schoolgirl, formerly of California, was killed). (*Yediot Ahronot*, March 6, 1998) Hanudeh is living freely in PA territory.

6. **Hassan Hamadan:** According to an Israeli Justice Ministry Report on October 21, 1998, Hamadan was involved in the April 9, 1995, bombing attack on an Israeli bus near Kfar Darom, in which seven Israelis and one American, Alisa Flatow, a student at Brandeis University were killed. Hamadan is a free man, residing in PA territory.

7. **Imjad Hinawi:** According to the Israeli government, Hinawi was involved in the May 13, 1996 murder of 17 year-old David Boim, a dual Israeli-American citizen. Hinawi was detained by the PA police in early 1997, but released for a weekend leave and did not return to prison. On September 17, 1997, Israel asked the PA to extradite Hinawi; the PA ignored the request.

In February 1998, Hinawi was re-arrested by the PA, put on trial, and sentenced to 10 years in jail. According to a November 1998 Israeli government report, Hinawi is a free man, residing in PA territory.

8. **Nasser Hindawi:** According to an Israeli Justice Ministry Report on October 21, 1998, Hindawi was involved in the April 9, 1995, bombing attack on an Israeli bus near Kfar Darom, in which seven Israelis and one American, Alisa Flatow, a student at Brandeis University were killed. Hindawi is a free man, residing in PA territory.

9. **Bassam Issa:** The Israeli government has identified Issa as having helped train the terrorists who carried out the February 25, 1996 Jerusalem bus bombing, in which Jewish Theological Seminary student Matthew Eisenfeld and Sara Duker, who were planning to be married, and Ira Weinstein, all U.S. citizens, were murdered. Issa is presently serving in the Palestinian Preventive Security Forces. On July 7, 1996, Israel asked the PA to extradite Issa; the PA has ignored the request.

10. **Kamal Khalifa:** He has been identified in an Israeli government report (*Jerusalem Post*, July 3, 1998) as having taken part in the preparations for the the February 25, 1996 Jerusalem bus bombing, in which Jewish Theological Seminary student Matthew Eisenfeld and Sara Duker, who were planning to be married, and

Ira Weinstein, all U.S. citizens, were murdered. Khalifa is presently serving in the Palestinian Preventive Security Forces.

11. **Yasser Yusef Mustafa Khasin:** He has been identified in an Israeli government report (*Jerusalem Post*, July 3, 1998) as having taken part in the preparations for the the February 25, 1996 Jerusalem bus bombing, in which Jewish Theological Seminary student Matthew Eisenfeld and Sara Duker, who were planning to be married, and Ira Weinstein, all U.S. citizens, were murdered. Khasin is presently serving in the Palestinian Preventive Security Forces.

12. **Nafez Sabih:** According to the Israeli government, Sabih helped plan the February 25, 1996 Jerusalem bus bombing, in which Jewish Theological Seminary student Matthew Eisenfeld and Sara Duker, who were planning to be married, and Ira Weinstein, all U.S. citizens, were murdered. On March 31, 1997, Israel asked the PA to extradite Sabih; the PA has ignored the request.

According to a November 1998 Israeli government report, Sabih "currently serves in the Palestinian security forces."

13. **Yousef Samiri:** According to an Israeli Justice Ministry Report on October 21, 1998, Samiri was involved in the April 9, 1995, bombing attack on an Israeli bus near Kfar Darom, in which seven Israelis and one American, Alisa Flatow, a student at Brandeis University were killed. Samiri is a free man, residing in PA territory.

14. **Mahmad Sanwar:** He has been identified in an Israeli government report (*Jerusalem Post*, July 3, 1998) as having taken part in the preparations for the the February 25, 1996 Jerusalem bus bombing, in which Jewish Theological Seminary student Matthew Eisenfeld and Sara Duker, who were planning to be married, and Ira Weinstein, all U.S. citizens, were murdered. Sanwar is presently serving in the Palestinian Preventive Security Forces.

15. **Nabil Sharihi:** According to an Israeli Justice Ministry Report on October 21, 1998, Sharihi was involved in the April 9, 1995, bombing attack on an Israeli bus near Kfar Darom, in which seven Israelis and one American, Alisa Flatow, a student at Brandeis University were killed. Sharihi is reportedly in PA detention, although, even if true, that would not relieve the PA of its obligation, in the Oslo accords, to extradite Sharihi to Israel.

Palestinian Arab Terrorists Who Took Part in the Murders of Americans Prior to the Oslo Accords (Sept.1993)

1. **Mohammed Abbas (Abu Abbas):** Abbas, the leader of the Palestine Liberation Front, a PLO faction, was convicted in absentia, in Italy in 1986, for masterminding the 1985 hijacking of the *S.S. Achille Lauro*, in which Leon

Klinghoffer, an American Jewish tourist, was murdered.

Abbas attended a session of the PLO's Palestine National Council, in PA-controlled Gaza, in April 1996. Later in 1996, he was reported to be in Iraq. In May 1998, he returned to the Gaza Strip, saying he intends to live there permanently.

2. Atef A'seiso: A'seiso was one of the masterminds of the 1972 Munich Olympics massacre in which David Berger, a member of the Israeli athletic team who was also an American citizen, was murdered. Later, A'seiso served as chief of security for the Palestinian Arab delegation to the 1991 Madrid Conference.

3. Abu Daoud: Daoud was involved in planning the 1972 Munich Olympics massacre in which David Berger, a member of the Israeli athletic team who was also an American citizen, was murdered.

Daoud currently resides in the PA-controlled city of Ramallah. (*Jerusalem Post*, September 7, 1997)

4. Amin el-Hindi: Hindi, is currently chief of the PA's General Intelligence Service. He masterminded the 1972 Munich Olympics massacre in which David Berger, a member of the Israeli athletic team who was also an American citizen, was murdered. (*New York Times*, October 14, 1993)
