

The Record: Fatah Violence Since the Signing

Period Covered: September 13, 1993 - May 1, 1994

Since the signing of the Declaration of Principles in September, 1993, members of Fatah, the main branch of the PLO, committed no fewer than 37 acts of violence against Israeli targets.

**Fatah has committed at least 28 acts of violence
since the signing of the DOP**

Last night's incident in Jebalya, in which 6 Fatah members were killed by IDF fire, raises the question as to whether IDF soldiers are justified in viewing armed Fatah activists as possible threats. As background in addressing this question, research by *Peace Watch* indicates that since the signing of the DOP Fatah members have been involved in 28 terrorist incidents against Israeli targets.

Peace Watch, a independent non-partisan organization monitoring the implementation of the accords signed between Israel and the PLO, has tallied 19 Fatah terrorist acts in the Gaza Strip, 2 in the West Bank, and 7 within the borders of the State of Israel.
